## Brag Board 2018

### Guidelines for a Brag Board

- The locals and regions may submit Brag Boards. Prepare a brag board highlighting local or regional activities for the current year (2018)
- The brag board should contain the five goals developed and adopted by the NCRSP Strategic Plan (Membership, Legislative, Communication, Community Service and Accountability/Leadership).
- The examples that fall under each area are to be utilized as a foundation to develop an individual local or region program of the organization. Using the following criteria that will align local and region activities with the mission and state program goals of NCRSP and promote uniform efforts to create a valuable community service and public recognition of the organization.
- The brag boards should demonstrate the activities of the local/region which enhance the objectives of the Strategic Plan of the NCRSP.
- The boards will be on display at the annual State Convention and the local and region participants will be recognized at the banquet.
