

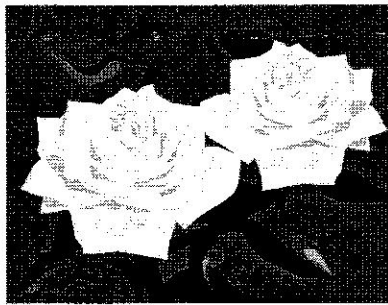

LEGISLATIVE REPORT

Several important actions were taken by the General Assembly before they adjourned. Here are two of the more important ones:

1. The legislature appropriated the amount of money needed to keep our retirement system in good shape. They also changed the vesting period from five to ten years.
2. The legislature took several actions regarding our health plan. If you are in the 80-20 plan and medicare eligible, you must now pay a monthly premium of \$10. If you are not medicare eligible your monthly premium will be \$21.62. It will be deducted from your retirement check beginning with the September check. If you are in the 70-30 plan, no deduction is needed. They also transferred the State Health Plan to the office of the state treasurer. There is also a 5.3 % increase in dependent coverage for the 2011/12 benefit year.
