April 21, 2016

The Stanly County Unit of NCRSP met at Dennis Vineyards, A Place in the Vineyard, on Thursday, April 21, 2016 with 47 members and 4 guests in attendance. President Mary Adkins called the meeting to order at 11:30 and welcomed members and guests.
