Here's how **\$3,818,308** in lottery funds flowed into projects and programs in **Stanly County**.



Non-Instructional Support: \$2,069,813

It takes a team to make a school work. Last year lottery funds helped public and charter schools with the cost of support staff, including substitute teachers, custodians, and office assistants.



Pre-K: \$906,235

Being ready to learn helps kids get the most out of school. With help from lottery funds, 163 children were provided a free, academic pre-school experience last year.



School Construction: \$581,265

Students need a safe place to learn and teachers a safe place to teach. School systems use lottery funds to support school construction and repair projects. Every dollar raised by the lottery is one less that has to come from other means like property taxes.



Scholarships and Grants: \$260,995

Scholarships and grants help make dreams of college become reality. Last year, 203 students received a need-based lottery scholarship and 203 students received a UNC Need-Based Grant with help from lottery funds.

More than \$34,686,972 in lottery funds have supported education programs in **Stanly County** since 2006.
