Leadership Team Meeting Minutes

August 8, 2017

Officers of the Stanly County Unit met on August 8, 2017 at the lake home of Cindy Misenheimer to plan for the year. In attendance were: Melissa Belk, Claudette Burris, Teresa Carriker, Doris Eudy, Rita Griffin, Ann Lowder and Cindy Misenheimer.

NCAE President Melissa Belk shared information about block scheduling, school supplies needed, continuing decrease in membership, and plans to promote membership in Stanly County to teachers, assistants, and substitutes. The present membership of 88 is the lowest in several years.

Melissa shared that she is requesting approval from the school superintendent to have a Celebration of Education on September 12, 2017 from 4:30 PM to 8:00 PM at Dennis Vineyard. All employees will be invited to enjoy a glass of wine and finger foods provided by the NCAE and other supporting organizations. Mark Jewell will be invited to speak to educators during the event.

The officers were in agreement to help individually or with a monetary donation from the NCRSP when plans are completed for this event. We will also assist with the collection of school supplies for Central Elementary School at the first NCRSP meeting scheduled. Suggested items for the collection are as follows: dry erase markers, Clorox wipes, pencils, glue sticks, Kleenex, and plastic lunch bags.

Cindy shared the meeting dates for the NCRSP for 2017-2018 scheduled at First Baptist Church in Albemarle. (See Attachment)

Cindy shared survey results received from members concerning meetings, programs, handbook information, highlights, scholarship raffle collections, door prizes, and phone tree contacts. (See Attachment)

Program ideas were discussed and the tentative schedule is as follows: September – health issues with Carolina Health representative, October – AARP representative, December – bingo/carols/ugly sweater social, February – Stanly County Schools curriculum overview/update, March – West Stanly Christian Ministries report and collection, and April – no program scheduled.

Cindy shared convention highlights and mentioned that officers should be in attendance. She reminded the officers that five delegates need to be in attendance to continue to receive Gold Star Status. Cindy also shared that updates for the Gold Star Status received at convention will be included in the handbook.

Cindy distributed copies of the budget for 2017-2018. Teresa Carriker updated information on the NCRSP Convention delegates expenses to \$1,551.91. (See Attachment)

Teresa Carriker distributed the Treasurer's Report for the local unit. She corrected the date for the checking account ending balance to show August 8, 2017. (See Attachment)

Cindy shared that the membership for the local unit is presently at 135. The officers were informed of the passing of Brenda Kimrey earlier this week in her email correspondence.

The NCRSP/Stanly County Unit will participate in a reception for retirees at the September 5, 2017 Stanly County Board of Education meeting at Central Elementary School. Cindy will contact officers with additional details about this reception by email.

Cindy reminded officers that prospective members can attend one meeting free. Guest attending the meetings who are not prospective members will be asked to pay for the luncheon. Post cards will be mailed to prospective members to invite them to the meetings scheduled this year.

The meeting was adjourned and the officers enjoyed a delicious salad bar luncheon provided by Cindy Misenheimer. Following the luncheon, the officers returned to a working meeting to prepare handbook information for the membership.
